Lewisboro Library Construction to Begin April 2

The Lewisboro Library will begin construction on its long-awaited expansion and renovation project on Wednesday, April 2. A groundbreaking ceremony is scheduled for Tuesday, April 1 at 3:30 pm.

During the building project, the Library will be relocating to the Social Hall of the South Salem Presbyterian Church, located at 111 Spring Street in South Salem. The temporary quarters will house a revolving portion of their collection, as well as computers for public use and Wi-Fi. Weekly story hours will continue as scheduled and special events and programs will take place on a more limited basis.

The current library building will be closed as of Sunday, March 16, to begin the process of packing up and transferring materials to the temporary location, with plans to open up there the week of March 24. During the transition period, deliveries from other Westchester Library System will be suspended. The Book Return will be open and at some point will be moved to the Church as we transition over. All items borrowed from now until March 16 will have an automatic extended return date of April 14.
