Rose & McQuillan Help Relaunch Lewisboro Library Building Campaign

The Campaign to Build the Lewisboro Library is off to a rousing revitalization, with a recent pledge of \$250,000 from local philanthropists Adam R. Rose and Peter R. McQuillan. Longtime residents of Cross River, Mr. Rose and Mr. McQuillan are well-known for their backing of numerous community projects, including the donation of the AP Farm Athletic Fields, and have supported the library expansion from its inception. “Peter and I feel that the Library is a crucial resource” said Mr. Rose “and it must grow to meet the changing needs of our residents.”

With all approvals in place, the Library Board and Staff are very excited for construction to begin this year. When the Building Campaign re-launched last month, \$2.1 million had already been raised, with a remaining \$1 million needed. “We are very grateful that Adam and Peter continue to take interest in the Library,” said Gary Page, President of the Lewisboro Library Board, “and will dedicate the Library’s new Reading Room in honor of Adam R. Rose and Peter R. McQuillan.
